## Standards of Respect—Flag Protocol

What order should we fly the flags of the United States, Washington state, or our Organization? What is the correct order to fly the flags of Military branches? Join us in October and learn the proper way to present the colors and teach us about flag protocol standards of respect for our meetings and events. You will learn how to display the United States flag properly in general, and with State flags, and with flags of various Organizations; as well as with flags of other Nations; how to properly display flags on speaker’s platforms at meetings and events; the protocol of flying flags over a street, at half staff, or on a casket; and how to raise and lower a flap properly, fold and store a flag properly, and display a flag in the proper manner.

### Directions from I-5 Southbound/Northbound

**From Southbound I-5:** 1. Take exit 105-B (City Center/Port of Olympia). Stay to the right (Port of Olympia exit). You are now on Plum St. 2. Stay on Plum St. until the intersection of Plum and 8th Ave. S.E. Turn right onto 8th Ave. S.E. 3. Drive approximately three blocks to the intersection of 8th Ave. S.E. and Eastside St. 4. Turn right onto Eastside St. AWSP is the first driveway on your right.

**From Northbound I-5:** 1. Take Exit 105 (City Center/Port of Olympia). Stay to the right, circling back under I-5. Stay in the right-hand lane. 2. At the first light, turn left onto Plum St. Travel to intersection of Plum and 8th Ave. S.E. Turn right onto 8th Ave. S.E. 3. Drive approximately three blocks to the intersection of 8th Ave. S.E. and Eastside St. 4. Turn right onto Eastside Street. AWSP is the first driveway on your right.
